HANDLING ARIGHT THE WORD OF TRUTH

2Tim. 2:15

INTRODUCTION:

- A. Whether or not we understand the Bible is determined to a great degree by our motive as we approach its study.
- B. We may respect the Bible as sufficient, rejecting human creeds, yet still be wrong in understanding
- C. The devil quoted scripture Matt 4:6,7; his ministers are deceptive 2Cor 11:14,15 They misapply & pervert
- D. We must rid ourselves of improper motives and attitudes or we are susceptible to false teachers
- E. The results attained in study are determined by: desire for truth, willingness to learn, reverence and respect for God's will and our recognition of our need for what God can supply. DISCUSSION:

I. GIVE THE WORD OF GOD A FAIR HEARING

- A. Study all the Bible says on any given subject
 - 1. Truth doesn't contradict self; yet without hearing all testimony we may form incorrect conclusions
 - 2. Does Jhn 3:16 teach only belief necessary to save? a. Some believers lost Jhn 12:42, 43; Jas 2:19
 - b. Saving faith is obedient Jas 2:14-26
- B Do not study to justify yourself
 - Not weakness to admit "I was wrong" must search for truth not just to prove "I'm not wrong"
 - 2. Jesus questioned people from this motive Lk 16:15
 - 3. Blind man doesn't test ground already covered we walk by faith not by sight 2Cor 5:7

II. ACCEPT THÉ SCRIPTURE AT FACE VALUE

- A. Let the Bible mean what it says
 - 1. God revealed what we need Eph 3:3-5 (Deut 29:29)
 - 2. Some can't see simple truths look for something deeper and miss point Col 2:6-8
 - 3. False teachers often use more difficult passages to prove position 2Pet 3:14-17
 - Approach difficult scripture open minded don't make them say more than they do or accept a view which contradicts other plain passages
 - b. Never make passage fit your idea, but visa-versa
- B. Do not let prejudice blind you
 - 1. If we make decisions without fair treatment of all evidence, we blind ourselves to truth 2Thess 2:10-12
 - 2. Some do not understand Bible, but fault not God's or the Bible's Matt 13:14,15

III. LET BIBLE INTERPRET ITSELF

A. Understand difficult passages in light of clear ones

- B. Bible has "meat" & "milk" Heb 5:12-14
 - 1. Some passages are more difficult 2Pet 3:16
 - 2. Do not isolate scripture so as to form a contradiction, God is not author of confusion 1Cor 14:33
 - 3. Harmonize doubtful passages with ones more readily understood.
- C. Most important attitude is willingness to study for yourself Acts 17:11
 - 1. Others may help by teaching us Acts 8:31
 - 2. Ultimately we must think for ourselves Jhn 7:17

IV. BEWARE OF THE "IDOLS" OF THE DEVIL

- A. Personal Opinion: "I know Bible says... but I think, Jer 9:13-16; Isa 55:8,9
- B. Worldly Wisdom: "Dr. So and So said this, . . he is educated and should know. " 1Cor 1:18-31
- C. Ecclesiasticism'. "Our church teaches.,," religious leaders rejected Christ 2Tim 4:2-4; Jer 10:23
- D. Human Creeds: "The catechism (summary of religious doctrine) or my creed says" -- doctrines of men cause religious division Matt 15:7-9; Prov 14:12
- E. Inherited Traditions: "My parents believed,... and if it was good enough for them it's good enough for me." We must answer for ourselves Rom 14:12; Matt 10:37
- F. Convenience: "believe what you want we are all headed to the same place" Matt 7:21-23
- G. Popularity: "The majority believe this, surely so many could not be wrong" Matt 7:13,14

V. PROPERLY EVALUATE THE IMPORTANCE OF TRUTH

- A. Buy the truth and sell it not Prov 23:23
 - 1. Give up anything for the truth, obey then refuse to part with it for any price.
 - 2. Desire truth and be rewarded Matt 6:6; Jhn 17:17
 - 3. Handle truth with respect, reverence & obedience Rom 6:17.18
- B. Don't presume God will accept anything else
 - 1. Presumptuous sins are those that overstep proper bounds of God's word Psa 19:13; 1Sam 15:22,23
 - 2. Makes a difference whether we accept what God says without alteration Gal 1:6-8; 2Jhn 9; Rev 22:18,19

- A. God's word is everlasting, unchangeable, and the standard by which we will be judged 1Pet 1:23-25; Jhn 12:48
