# **HELL AND WHO IS GOING THERE**

Lk 16:19-26; Matt 25:41-46

#### **INTRODUCTION:**

- > A. For the most part people have very little concern about hell (Don't think there is such a place) Matt 5:22; 10:28
- > **HELL sheh-ole'** (From the Old Testament) From (7592); Hades or the world of the dead (as if a subterranean retreat), including its accessories and inmates:--grave, hell, pit. Psa 9:17
- > **HELL G86** "Hades" From (G1) (as a negative particle) and (G1492); properly unseen, that is, "Hades" or the place (state) of departed souls:-grave, hell Lk 16:23; Rev 20:13,14; Acts 2:27; **NOTE: Jesus went to PARADISE G3857** Of Oriental origin (compare [H6508]); a park, that is, (specifically) an Eden (place of future happiness, "paradise"): Lk 23:43 paradise (G3857).
- HELL (G5020) Tartaros (a division of Hades jlh) (the deepest abyss of Hades); to incarcerate in eternal torment:-cast down to hell. 2Pet 2:4
- > HELL (G1067) geenna Final resting place of the wicked: All those who died in state of wickedness will ultimately end up here. (In a few instances when "hell" is used and it refers to "hades" the righteous may be included, but they would be in "paradise" and wicked in "tartarus") Of Hebrew origin ([H1516] and [H2011]); valley of (the son of) Hinnom; gehenna (or Ge-Hinnom), a valley of Jerusalem, used (figuratively) as a name for the place (or state) of everlasting punishment:-hell. Matt 5:22; Matt 10:28
- > B. Rich man tried to warn others of hell Lk 16:27,28
- > C. The most repulsive thought of hell is the associates Rom 1:28-32; Gal 5:19-21
- > D. A view of hell (as used to describe interim holding place of the wicked and eternal abode of wicked) and it's population should make us try to avoid this place.

- > B. Those who believe but will not confess Jhn 12:42,43
- > C. Those who are uncharitable Matt 25:41-46; Lk 16:19

#### > III. RELIGIOUS PEOPLE WILL BE THERE

- > A. Done many wonderful works in His name Matt 7:21-23
- > B. False prophets 2Pet 2:1
- > C. Followed own ways instead of God's commandments Mk 7:7-9
  - 1. Keep not commands are liars 1Jhn 2:3,4
  - 2. Liars have place in the lake of fire Rev 21:8

### > IV. GOOD MORAL PEOPLE WILL BE THERE

- > A. Cornelius not good enough Acts 10:1,2; 11:14
- > B. Rich young ruler Matt 19:16-22
  - 1. Had kept the commandments
  - 2. Yet not willing to follow Jesus
  - 3. Cannot say he was never saved but wasn't in his present condition

# > V. LUKEWARM CHRISTIANS (CHURCH MEMBERS) THERE

- > A. Must be active 1Cor 15:58; Rev 3:16
- > B. Backsliders condition worse than first 2Pet 2:20-22
- > C. Judgment begins at the house of the Lord 1Pet 4:17,18
- D. Gather out of his kingdom all things that offend and them which do iniquity Matt 13:41,42
- > E. Hypocrites are children of Hell Matt 23:15 CONCLUSION:
- > A. Hell is a real place and will be filled with all kinds of people
- > B. Do you fall into one of these classifications?
  - > 1. Satisfying the lust of the flesh
  - > 2. Uncharitable to your fellow man
  - > 3. Religious but wrong
  - > 4. Good morally yet not obedient
  - > 5. A lukewarm Christian
